On January 24, 2014, we announced our plans to discontinue manufacture and sales of the Acuity Central Monitoring System, Mobile Acuity LT, WACS (Welch Allyn Communications Server), Micropaq, Propaq CS, networked versions of the Propaq LT and networked Welch Allyn 1500 monitor after December 31, 2014.

This follow on letter is to inform you that Welch Allyn will also be discontinuing immediately all sales of the standalone versions of the 1500 Monitor product as well, as all current inventory of the product is depleted.

Welch Allyn will provide service and support for all the aforementioned products going end of life for up to five years or until parts and accessories are no longer available.
